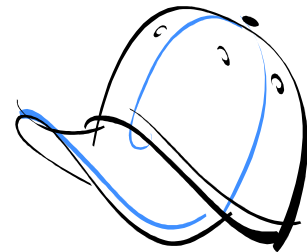
Memorial Day Mass

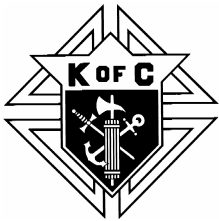

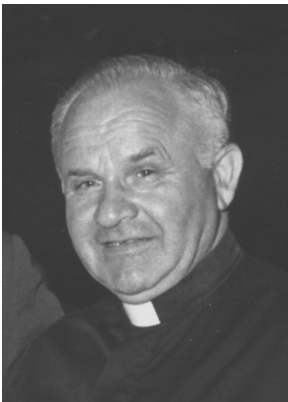
